


ANNUAL REPORT 2021-2022

UNIS Hanoi is a not-for-profit coeducational Englishlanguage day school enroling students from Early Years (3-year-olds) through to Grade 12. The School follows the ideals and principles of the United Nations in action every day. UNIS Hanoi is authorised by the Ministry of Education in Vietnam, accredited by the Council of International Schools, the Western Association of Schools and Colleges and the International Baccalaureate Organisation. It is administered by the Head of School, Jane McGee and governed by a ninemember Board of Directors.









School Community Organisation






Finances


Operating Income and Expenditures




Annual Capital Fees




Total Expenditure
