

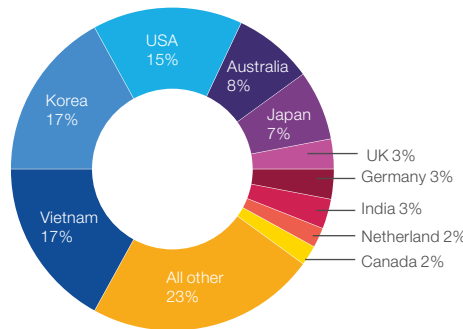
UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF HANOI HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2015 2016

The United Nations International School of Hanoi (UNIS) is a private, non-profit co educational English-language day school enrolling students from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12. The school was established in 1988 as a joint venture between the Vietnamese government and the United Nations to offer an education to the children of UN personnel, children of the diplomatic community and children of expatriates.

School Community

The 1121 students from Discovery (age 3) to Grade 12 come from more than 65 different countries including the host country Vietnam. Parents of UNIS students work in business, government agencies, and other professions. The students are a mobile community and the average length of stay is 3.2 years.

Academic Programme

UNIS was the first school in Asia authorized to offer three IB Programmes and is proud of the international education and awareness it provides. The IB Diploma Programme is a demanding pre-university internationally recognized course of study that leads to external exams at the end of the two year programme. The Diploma Programme is open to all UNIS students. In total, UNIS offers 28 DP IB courses at both Higher and Standard Level.

School Calendar

The school year consists of no less than 175 teacher-student contact days from mid-August through early June. Classes meet for approximately 80 minute periods every other day.

Graduation Requirements

23 credits are required for graduation and credit is issued by semester. Each full year course passed earns one credit. Specific credit requirements are as follows:

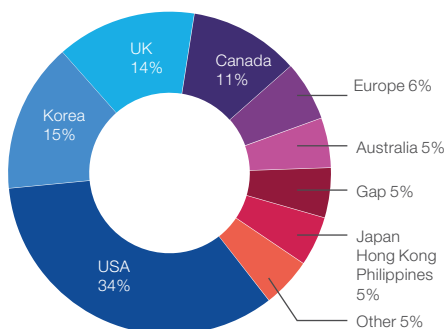
