

UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF HANOI 2017 HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2018

The United Nations International School of Hanoi (UNIS) is a private, non-profit co educational English-language day school enrolling students from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12. The School was established in 1988 as a joint venture between the Vietnamese government and the United Nations to offer an education to the children of UN personnel, the diplomatic community expatriates and local Vietnamese families.

UNIS Mission

“Our mission is to encourage students to be independent, lifelong learners who strive for excellence and become responsible stewards of our global society and natural environment, achieved within a supportive community that values diversity and through a programme reflecting the ideals and principles of the United Nations.”

School Community

The 1122 students from Discovery (age 3) to Grade 12 come from more than 64 different countries including the host country Vietnam. Parents of UNIS students work in business, government agencies, and other professions. The students are a mobile community and the average length of stay is 3.2 years.

Social/ Emotional and Academic Learning (SEAL)

In addition to the IB Diploma Community, Activity & Service programme UNIS dedicates daily scheduled time for Mentoring. The UNIS “Connections” Programme intentionally develops students’ and educators’ capacity for social and emotional growth through connection. The UNIS SEAL & Connections Programmes are designed to foster confidence in self-management as well as opportunities for students to facilitate friendships, clubs, teacher conferencing as well as interactive experiential learning activities.

Academic Programme

UNIS was the first school in Asia authorised to offer three IB Programmes and is proud of the international education and awareness it provides. The IB Diploma Programme is a demanding pre-university internationally recognised course of study that leads to external exams at the end of the two year programme. The Diploma Programme is open to all UNIS students. In total, UNIS offers 28 DP IB courses at both Higher and Standard Level.

School Calendar

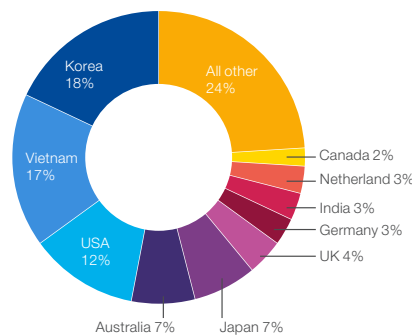
The school year consists of no less than 175 teacher-student contact days from mid-August through mid-June. Each subject class meets for approximately 65 minutes every other day.

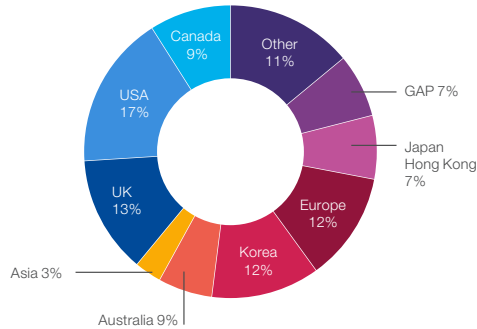
